



## NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION

The Albuquerque Girl Choir (AGC) is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization managed by a volunteer Board of Directors. The Board of Directors recruits members, raises funds, determines tuition and fees, sets policy, and hires qualified professional music directors and accompanists. The Board is open to any parent or member of the community interested in helping to manage the choir. The Bylaws require a minimum of 3 members and no more than 7.

## REHEARSALS

Rehearsals are held Thursdays at First Presbyterian Church, 215 Locust St NE, Albuquerque.

### Main Choir- 5:00 - 6:00 PM

- The Main Choir welcomes girls in grades 2–12 and serves as the heart of the Albuquerque Girl Choir program. Choir members build strong musical skills and foundational knowledge through vocal training, music reading, and ensemble work. The repertoire includes unison and two-part music, with selections drawn from a variety of cultures and traditions. This choir fosters a love of singing, teamwork, and musical growth in a supportive and engaging environment.

### Advanced Choir-5:30 - 6:45 PM

- The Advanced Choir is an auditioned ensemble for students in grades 4–12, offering a challenging and enriching experience for developing musicians. Singers focus on advanced vocal technique, music theory, and performance skills while exploring a diverse and sophisticated repertoire. This choir provides opportunities for artistic growth, leadership, and high-level ensemble singing.
- Auditions will be held after rehearsal on **January 22, 2026**. The only song girls need to come prepared with is the “Happy Birthday” song.

Parents are not required to stay during rehearsals but, we do ask that the **girls get picked up inside the church and on time for safety**. Please contact the director through the band app if you’re running late.

Rehearsals culminate with a snack and socialization. Each week an AGC Family provides snacks for the girls during Thursday rehearsal. Please sign-up for a snack week! Snack Sign-Up is located at the AGC Website in the Member’s Tab, under the Snacks Link. This family will be in charge of setting up snack for that week and cleaning up snack and community areas.

Additional rehearsals are scheduled occasionally to prepare for performances. AGC will not practice if ABQ Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather. AGC will not practice during Spring Break.



## ALBUQUERQUE GIRL CHOIR ATTENDANCE POLICY

Consistent attendance is essential to each singer's growth and to the success of the ensemble. Singers are allowed up to **three unexcused absences** per semester. After the third unexcused absence, **participation in the final concert will be at the discretion of the director.**

**Excused absences** must be communicated **in advance** via **direct message on the BAND app**. Failure to notify the director in this manner may result in the absence being marked as unexcused.

## PROGRAM COSTS

Tuition per semester:

New Members-\$342 (Price includes Season Registration Fee, AGC Pink Shirt and Black Hoodie)

Returning Members \$300 (Price includes Registration Fee only)

Uniform costs are formal dress (~\$30)

To help save costs, we do offer:

- Scholarships – 50% off registration only(not AGC Pink Shirt and Black Hoodie) .
- 20% discount per child for multiple children in the same family(Sibling discount for registration fee only, not AGC Pink Shirt and Black Hoodie).

Please speak to a board member directly and by email to arrange a sibling discount and to discuss scholarships. All scholarship requests, discounts, and AGC registrations are due **Sunday, January 25**, so that the Board can budget and forecast accordingly for the term.

## PERFORMANCES (WHERE OUR HARD WORK PAYS OFF!)

Because performance is part of our mission, we strive to schedule 3-4 performances per semester. Each term culminates with a formal performance. Past performances have been at the Lobo Basketball games, ABQ Botanical Garden's River of Lights, Balloon Fiesta, Isotopes and United games, as well as frequent visits to local retirement centers. The choir will sometimes perform with other music groups such as the Durango Children's Choir, ABQ Boy Choir, and the ABQ Youth Symphony. The performance schedule is updated on the Events page of our website and on the AGC Band App and parents are also notified as dates are firmed up.

If your child is not able to regularly rehearse, they are not guaranteed the right to perform. **If your child has not been able to attend rehearsals leading up to a performance or has THREE or more unexcused absences, please check in with the Choir Director to determine if they are ready to perform.**

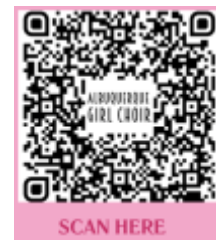


## COMMUNICATION

To keep expenses as low as possible, AGC relies heavily on parents to contribute time and talent. We ask all families to volunteer in some way each session. Signups and information about volunteer opportunities will be shared throughout the sessions.

If there is a need for additional funds beyond what is available through tuition and grants, the choir may conduct fundraisers. These will be announced and coordinated on an "as needed" basis. All choir members are expected to help with these events.

- Closed-toed shoes

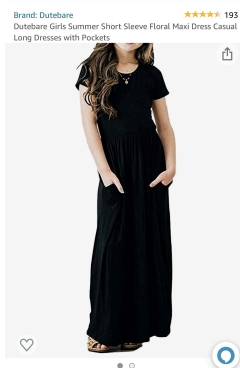
A current AGC Pink performance shirt must be purchased at the time of registration. This will help us ensure that all girls are ready to perform, should a performance come available.
