

The **Brent Flexible Learning Plan** is designed to ensure that education at Brent Baguio remains uninterrupted, even during unexpected school-wide closures caused by typhoons. This plan enables students to stay engaged and make progress in their studies through a flexible, accessible approach that meets the unique demands of weather-related challenges.

Key Components of the Brent Flexible Learning Plan:

- Google Classroom: Teachers will post assignments, resources, and instructions
 on Google Classroom, allowing students to access and complete their work at
 their own pace when internet connectivity is available.
- Learning Packets: For families who may encounter intermittent internet or power issues, prepared learning packets offer an offline alternative to ensure all students can continue their learning. These packets contain essential materials and activities aligned with the curriculum and cover core subjects.
- Live Online Classes (Synchronous Learning): When conditions permit, teachers may conduct live online classes to keep students connected and engaged. These sessions, hosted on compatible platforms, provide real-time interaction and support. Participation in live classes may vary based on individual circumstances, and recorded sessions or follow-up resources will be made available when possible. Flexibility and Accessibility: We recognize that during typhoon-related closures, circumstances may differ widely among families. The Brent Flexible Learning Plan offers a range of options to accommodate varying levels of access, with safety as the primary priority. Students are encouraged to participate in ways that best fit their family's situation.

Applicability: This plan is activated exclusively for school-wide closures due to weather-related disruptions and does not apply to regular holidays or individual absences due to vacations or sick days.

The **Brent Flexible Learning Plan** embodies our commitment to providing continuity in learning and supporting the resilience of our students, teachers, and families—keeping our community connected, no matter the weather.



To ensure learning continues smoothly, we have a schedule and flexible VIRTUAL LEARNING plan via Google Meet in place for all students from Grade 3 to Grade 12. Teachers will share Google Meet links with parents and students via email or chat.

For Grade 3 - 5:

- 2. Short, Interactive Virtual Sessions:
 - Grade 3-5 sessions will last 20-30 minutes. Teachers will guide students through key activities, keeping screen time minimal.
 - Teachers will be available for the entire block via the Google Meet link provided to support students, but sessions will be flexible and short to ensure students stay engaged without extended screen time.

 Learning packets will be provided for offline tasks. If your child cannot join online, they can still continue learning with these materials.

For Grades 6-12:

- 1. Google Classroom & Virtual Sessions:
 - There will be one-hour blocks from 8 AM to 12:30 PM. Teachers will be available for the entire hour, but students may not need to stay online for the full time—teachers will focus on essential content, discussions, and answering questions.
 - Teachers will share Google Meet links via email or chat for easy access.
- 2. Flexibility for students:
 - We understand that power and internet issues may arise. Students can complete assignments from Google Classroom at their own pace if they cannot join live sessions. Attendance will be noted/recorded and will not affect the Perfect Attendance awards.

Flexibility for Teachers:

- Just like students, some teachers may face connectivity issues or power outages. If teachers are unable to work from home, they can use their classrooms at school, provided it's safe to travel. Teachers will communicate with students/parents via email or by other possible means if there are any adjustments needed due to these circumstances.
