



RC Race Track Update

Robb Hartzog and new member Scott Ballinger have been working on the design parameters of the RC Car Race Track, laying out the lanes, the jumps and placing the lane and perimeter dividers. Helping with dirt distribution and placement, (fancy words for shoveling and raking), were Doug Martel, Steady Higgins, Press McCance, and Geoff Wasteneys. I would be remiss if I did not thank the park officials for their tremendous help in loaning us some heavy equipment and delivering close to 10 tons of fill dirt to shape the racetrack. The park is also providing us with surplus building materials at no charge to build the elevated drivers' stand and to build the safety enclosure around the front of the track. The track is really taking shape and some volunteers are already taking some "test spins". We moved some building materials from the storage yard to the airfield last Saturday and will keep the progress in motion. This RC Car Racetrack is the perfect remedy for days when it is too windy to fly. Just put your plane away, get out your RC car, and get your "RC Fix"! What, you don't have an RC car or truck yet? GET ONE! They are a blast!

Safety Corner - Bud Glass, AMA Safety Officer

Attention helicopter and drone pilots. There are three designated multi-rotor flying areas and helipads for your use. Multirotor aircraft may not be flown from either runway, taxiways, sidewalks, pits, parking lot, from assembly tables, or anywhere else, regardless of who's present, wind direction, sun angle, or any other excuse you may have. The rules that govern multirotor aircraft are SAFETY RULES and must be adhered to at all times.





New Lightning Information on the weather page (submitted by Terry Hock)

The club's weather station at the field has been upgraded to provide information on lightning strikes in the area. The temperature and wind sensor on the pole now includes a module that can detect lightning strikes within approximately a 25-mile radius around Chatfield. This module functions similarly to an AM radio by picking up static from lightning strikes, but it is specifically designed to detect only lightning strikes, using a small 500 kHz antenna and signal processing to distinguish between lightning strikes and other types of radio noise. The weather web page has been updated to display the number of lightning strikes detected over a 5-minute period, the total number of lightning strikes for the day, and a plot showing when the lightning activity occurred. Below are plots from August 9th, when a thunderstorm with rain and lightning occurred, as shown. This provides additional awareness of lightning in the area, enhancing safety at the field.







Helipad Reminder, FPV Racing Drone restrictions

A new helipad has been added to the south end of the new diagonal runway. Only one helipad may be used at the same time, and heli operations are prohibited from anywhere other than one of the three designated helipads. FPV Racing Drones may fly in the field south of the parking lot and must remain within the 100 ft. X 200 ft. area designated by the 4 white corner poles.




