Background

AL-Rafi Haddad was born in **Urzikstan** to Syrian refugee parents who fled Aleppo during the early civil war. Growing up amid occupation, violence, and resistance shaped him early.

When the **Urzikstan Liberation Force**, led by **Farah Karim**, rose against AL-Qatala, AL-Rafi joined as a young operative, specializing in **intelligence gathering and infiltration**. His aptitude for languages and reading human behavior made him one of the resistance's most valuable field agents.

After liberation, AL-Rafi continued working alongside allied forces as a **liaison, interpreter, and covert scout**. His composed demeanor during a tense operation in Eastern Europe drew the attention of **Captain John Price**, who saw in him not just skill, but control.

Price later offered him a place in **Task Force 141**, assigning him the callsign **Jackal** — a nod to his adaptability and survival instinct.

Though no longer part of Farah's force, AL-Rafi maintains contact with her, exchanging intelligence when necessary. Their relationship is built on respect, shared history, and the knowledge that both still fight the same war — just from different fronts.

Military & Tactical Skills

- **Human Intelligence (HUMINT):** Skilled in interrogation, reading micro-expressions, and social infiltration.

- **Linguistics:** Serves as 141's field translator and negotiator during cross-border ops.

Combat Knife: Custom black-handled blade engraved with a small jackal head symbol

Equipment: Flashbangs, smoke grenades, grappling line, and signal disruptor

Armor / Gear: Lightweight tactical vest for mobility, tan combat fatigues, keffiyeh scarf

Special Tools: Portable translator pad, encrypted comms interface for intel data extraction

Captain John Price:

Mentor figure. Price trusts his instincts and sends him on recon or negotiation-heavy assignments.

Simon "Ghost" Riley:

Mutual respect. Both men operate best in silence, understanding each other's methods without many words. Ghost occasionally teases Jackal's calmness as "unnerving."

John "Soap" MacTavish:

Opposite energies. Soap's high energy and humor bounce off Jackal's stoicism, often creating banter. Jackal grounds Soap when missions grow tense.

Kyle "Gaz" Garrick:

Good tactical chemistry; often paired during urban missions for coordinated breaching and intel recovery.

Farah Karim:

Former ally and comrade. They share mutual admiration and an unspoken sense of unfinished duty.

Voice & Speech

- Calm, deep tone; carries a faint Syrian-Urzikstani accent.
- Chooses words carefully, rarely raises his voice.
- Occasionally slips into Arabic mid-sentence when irritated.
- Has a steady, quiet laugh — more like an exhale than a sound.

Trivia

- Collects small trinkets from every mission (coins, tags, bullet casings).
- Favorite phrase: *"Let silence do the work."*
- Once disappeared behind enemy lines for three days and returned with full intel and no backup — earned his callsign "Jackal."
- Often acts as the team's moral compass, even when he pretends not to.
