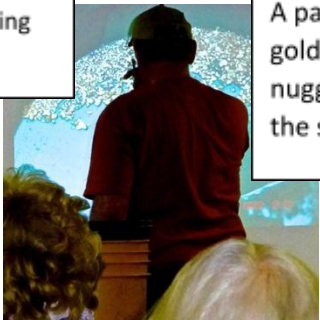

He emphasized that while the Borough would help in emergencies, correcting the landslide problem was the responsibility of the Alaska Dept. of Transportation. The CLSCCI is looking forward to hearing from ADOT. Senator Bjorkman's office had a response from the ADOT May 5. ADOT doesn't feel the road is in any danger of failing. They are monitoring it. Senator Bjorkman was subsequently notified about the cement trucks that will be running over that road soon as work on the bypass continues.
