Methods (15 points)	• Uses at least 2 text features. Text features include but are not limited to bulleted lists, titles, subtitles, graphs, charts, maps, photographs, illustrations, bolded words, italicized words, highlighted text, big text, small text, timelines, labels and diagrams, glossary, table of contents, index, etc. • Uses at least 2 text structures. Text structures include but are not limited to description, sequence and order, compare and contrast, cause and effect, problem and solution, question and answer, etc. • Methods used are specifically chosen to be effective and help the reader understand the role of a forensic anthropologist. Exemplary: Methods used are purposeful and help the reader better understand the text. At least 4 text features are used and some include visual representation. Uses at least 3 text structures.		
Role of a Forensic Anthropologist (15 points)	• The Write Like answers the following questions about forensic anthropologists throughout the piece: ○ What do they do? ○ What don't they do? ○ When do they become involved? ○ What do they do with bones? ○ What are their labs like? ○ Facial reconstruction? Exemplary: All aspects of the role of a forensic anthropologist are abundantly clear. The Write Like contains all roles of a forensic anthropologist but is unique to the writer and organized in a unique way.		
Forensic Anthropology/ Crime-Solving terms (15 points)	• Includes at least 10 forensic anthropology and crime-solving terms. See the classroom anchor chart for examples of forensic anthropology and crime-solving terms. Exemplary: Includes at least 15 forensic anthropology and crime-solving terms. Uses the terms in an effective and efficient manner.		

Conventions (5 points)	• Title is present and clear. • Words are spelled correctly. • Words are correctly capitalized. • Complete sentences are present. There are no run-ons or fragments unless they are part of a heading, subtitle, title, etc. • A variety of fonts and sizes may be used, but paragraph text should be in a professional, easy to read font (such as Cambria, Arial, Times New Roman and Calibri) • Write Like is at least 1 ½ pages long
