Family File

The 2026-2027 Family File is now available to parents.

HCPSS requires that your Family File is completed BEFORE you can see your child's teacher on August 19th.

Every year HCPSS parents must complete a Family File for each child. HCPSS utilizes Family File for parents/guardians to complete emergency information. Parents/guardians must verify and/or update information for each child, and can do so by logging in to [HCPSS Connect](#) PARENT ACCOUNT and selecting the MORE OPTIONS tab on the left and then click on Family File.

Once logged in, you will be asked to update or provide the following information:

- Student Information
- Parent/Guardian Contact
- Emergency Contacts
- Medical Information
- Arrival/Dismissal Procedures
- Photo Approval Data Confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA Directory

Again, it is important that you complete the Family File in order to receive the name of your child's teacher for the upcoming school year.

Transportation Information

The online HCPSS bus stop locator is scheduled to be available Wednesday, Aug. 19. At that time, eligible families can access bus stop locations, and pickup/dropoff times.

Free and Reduced Meals

Free and Reduced Meals - check your eligibility today!

Many HCPSS families may be eligible to receive benefits through the [Free and Reduced Price Meals \(FARMs\) program](#).

Qualifying families can take advantage of a wide range of additional resources and discounts, including free college applications, free or reduced JumpStart dual enrollment tuition, discounted internet through the Comcast Internet Essentials program, and more.

Families must submit a new application every school year. During the first 30 school days, students with FARMs eligibility from the prior school year will continue to receive benefits. Any student whose family has not filled out an application by the 30th school day will have their status changed to full pay until a new application is received.

Parents/guardians are highly encouraged to fill out the applications as soon as possible. It is very important that applications are filled out accurately and completely.

Parent Volunteers & Classroom Observations:

As a reminder, all volunteers are required to complete the HCPSS Confidentiality Training and Child Abuse and Neglect Training prior to volunteering in the school building or on a field trip.

Additionally, parents conducting classroom visits and observations must complete the Confidentiality Agreement for visits/observations. All documents can be found on the [HCPSS website](#)

Birthday Celebrations

We know and appreciate that families want to recognize their children's birthdays and participate in other class celebrations. However, it is important to remember that [HCPSS Policy 9090: Wellness Through Nutrition and Physical Activity](#) does not allow for parents (or staff) to bring in food for these kinds of occasions. You may bring in something special for your own child, but any food items cannot be shared with other students. If you'd like to provide a goodie bag to the class, consider including items like pencils, fidgets, or other small, non-food items

When there are class celebrations throughout the year, the community will be notified of any food items that will be provided for students. These food items will be in alignment with HCPSS Policy 9090 and meet the required nutritional guidelines. If you would prefer that your child not have what is being offered, you may choose to send in an alternate item.

Also, please note that HCPSS provides a circular to all schools each year prohibiting the presence of latex balloons in school buildings. Any balloons used for decoration or celebration in the building must be latex-free.
