### Academic Lab Ms. Botte

#### Purpose:

Academic Lab aims to improve students' comprehension of core subjects at their grade level, including math, English Language Arts (ELA), science, and social studies/history. This lab offers a chance for students to see grade-level academic skills demonstrated, presented visually, and broken down into manageable steps, enhancing their understanding.

Additionally, students will focus on organizational skills, learning effective methods to complete assignments and manage their time efficiently. The effort students invest in this class directly influences what they gain from it! Therefore, it is crucial to arrive each day prepared, with a positive mindset, and ready to engage in learning.

### **Grading Procedure:**

Given that this class relies heavily on student involvement, the following two aspects will be assessed daily:

- Teacher evaluation of work habits 10 points per week (up to 2 points given per day), based on the following:
  - 2 points students participated throughout the hour
  - 1 point student required multiple reminders to participate
  - O points student was unwilling to participate (parents also contacted)
- Student grade checks students will learn how to access grades through Infinite Campus and will check their grades on a regular basis for 10 points

Final grades will be given based on a basic point system (number of points earned/total points = final grade percentage).
