Notearama Launches No-Code Knowledge Publishing System

New platform eliminates the need to migrate content into a separate website builder, blogging tool, or CMS, letting users publish directly from a variety of rich content creation tools.

SAN DIEGO, CA — July 29, 2026 — Notearama today announced the launch of an open beta for its Knowledge Publishing System, enabling creators, consultants, researchers, educators, and small businesses to instantly transform Evernote and OneNote notebooks into searchable public websites, without coding.

Millions of professionals use applications such as Evernote and Microsoft OneNote to capture valuable knowledge, research, procedures, project documentation, and expertise. Unfortunately, most of that information remains hidden inside private notebooks where customers, colleagues, search engines, and AI systems cannot find it.

Rather than requiring users to recreate content in a website builder or traditional content management system, Notearama connects directly to supported PKM applications and publishes selected notebooks as organized, searchable, continuously updated web content.

While Personal Knowledge Management apps like Evernote and Microsoft OneNote began as simple digital scratchpads, they have evolved into sophisticated, rich-media content creation tools where professionals write comprehensive guides, format complex research, and build entire knowledge bases. However, this high-value content typically remains trapped inside private silos. Notearama bridges this gap by connecting directly to these platforms, allowing users to publish selected notebooks as organized, searchable, and continuously updated web content without needing a separate website builder.

Notearama was founded with a deep understanding of note-taking workflows and user frustrations. The platform is led by Evernote's original VP of Product Management, David Nagy, who recognized a missed opportunity in how major note-taking apps treated sharing and publishing. Nagy designed the platform's product experience and go-to-market strategy, working with a distributed team of engineers to develop and deploy Notearama.

"Modern PKM apps have evolved far beyond basic notetaking; they are where many do their best, most thoroughly formatted and interconnected content creation and deep thinking," said Nagy, "Yet, sharing that work on the web has always meant tedious copying and pasting into website and blogging tools or costly and complex content

management systems. You keep creating exactly where you're comfortable, and we handle the publishing, hosting, and optimization."

Built for the Knowledge Economy

Notearama is designed for organizations and professionals who regularly create knowledge-rich content, including:

Instead of maintaining duplicate content across applications and websites, users simply continue working in their preferred PKM application while Notearama handles publishing.

- Optional automatic synchronization as notebooks evolve

- Content monetization through affiliate marketing and future premium publishing options
- AI-assisted review of content for grammar, formatting, style consistency, and terms of use compliance before publication.

A Living Knowledge Library

Unlike traditional content management systems that publish static web pages, Notearama creates what the company calls a Living Knowledge Library; knowledge that continuously evolves as authors update their notebooks.

This makes the platform especially valuable for documentation that changes frequently, including operating procedures, product documentation, research journals, educational materials, project updates, technical references, and consulting knowledge bases.

Current Integrations

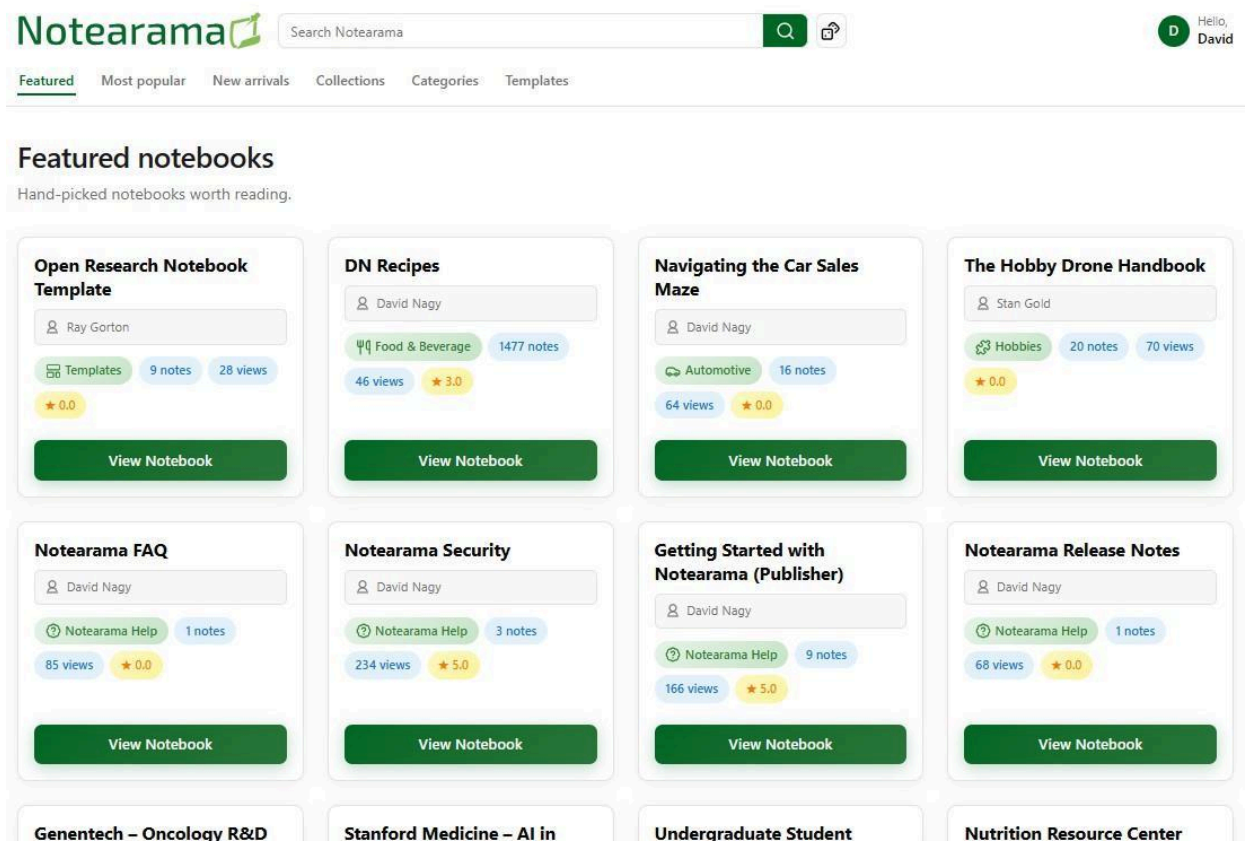
The initial release supports:

- Evernote
- Microsoft OneNote

Support for additional PKM platforms such as Google Keep, Notion, and Obsidian is planned for future releases, as well as support for grouping Markdown files into cohesive notebooks. Notearama's platform-agnostic import layer normalizes content from any source PKM app or Markdown file into a single internal note schema, so adding a new integration only requires building a lightweight connector/parser for that platform's export format rather than reworking the core publishing, review, and rendering pipeline.

Open Beta Availability

Notearama is available immediately. The platform is currently offered free during its initial launch period while the company continues expanding features and integrations.
