In a competitive matchup, Teays Valley emerged victorious, defeating Logan 3-0. The game showcased exceptional pitching from both teams.

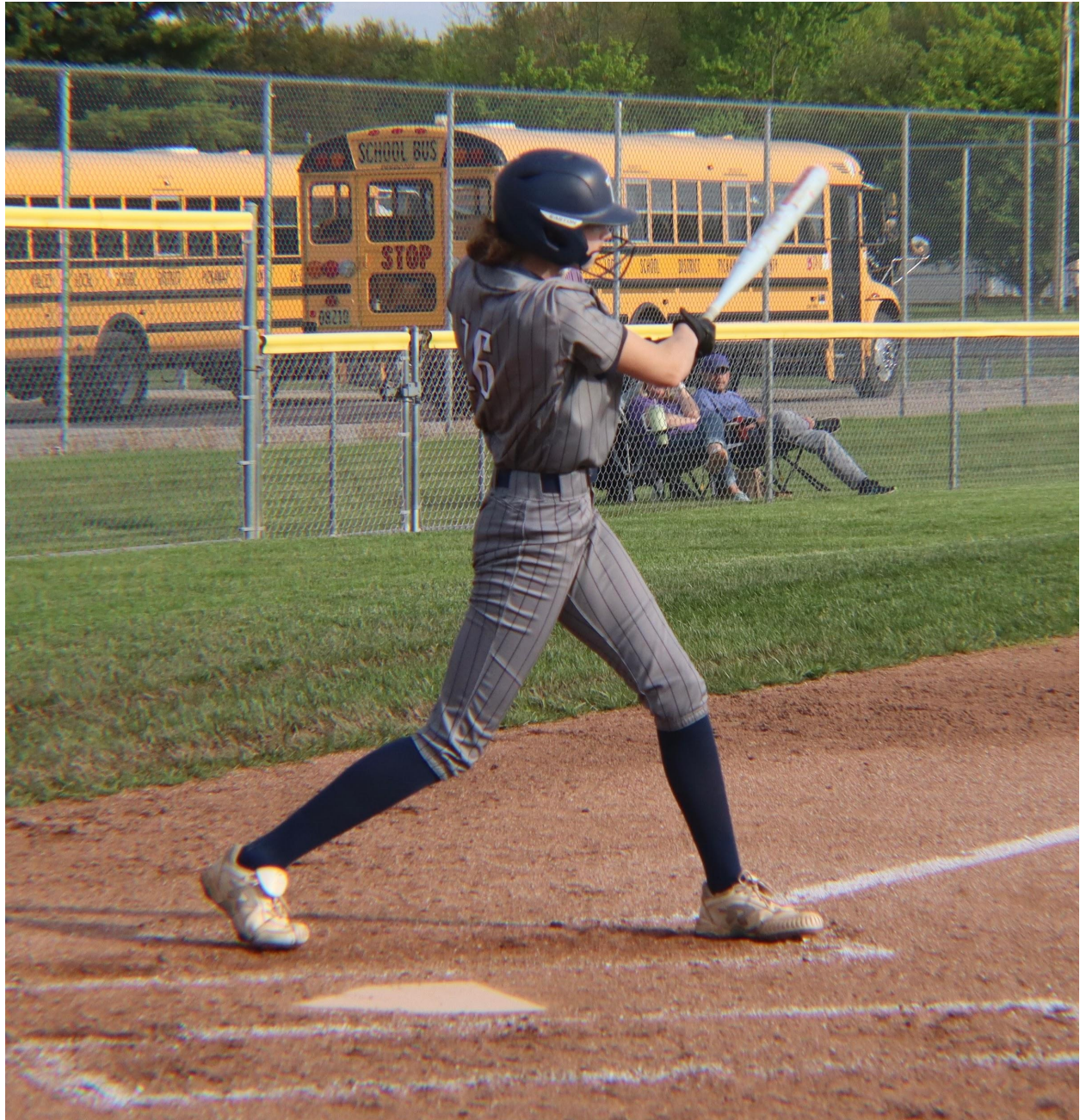
Alyvia Lawrentz was dominant on the mound for Teays Valley, starting the game and facing the minimum 21 outs. She pitched a shutout, surrendering zero hits and zero runs over seven innings while dispatching nine batters and walking none. Lawrentz earned the win for the Vikings.



The Vikings' offense came alive in the bottom of the fourth inning, scoring three runs. Sophia Hastler laid down a sacrifice bunt, scoring one run, and Avery Stratton followed with a double, scoring two runs. Stratton's two-bagger drove in two runs and gave the Vikings a 3-0 lead. Stratton led Teays Valley with two runs batted in, going 1-for-3 on the day. Avery Mann and Lawrentz each collected two hits for the Vikings, contributing to the team's offense.



Macie Mauck took the loss for Logan, pitching six innings and allowing three runs on six hits while striking out one and walking none.
