Solar Eclipse on April 8

The eclipse will last from 12:54-3:11 p.m., with the maximum eclipse occurring at 1:54 p.m.

Because this event will take place during the school day, we want to provide our students with a safe and fun experience. Students will be provided the opportunity to view the solar eclipse and order solar filter safety glasses that meet NASA's specifications, ensuring every student's eyes are protected throughout the event.

If you prefer your child NOT to participate in the solar eclipse viewing, please let your principal know.


