The Vibe + Safety

While no space can be completely safe and inclusive for everyone, this community gathering aims to create a comfortable, welcoming environment open to people from different experiences.

We are aiming for a **chilled and welcoming vibe** and ask that you do what you can to help us create this for everyone.

Behaviour that limits others ability to participate safely and comfortably in the space – including but not limited to racism, sexism, body shaming / fatphobia, transphobia, homo/bi/queerphobia, discrimination based on class, discrimination based on disability, and non-consensual behaviour – will not be tolerated.

If you are concerned anyone's behaviour is causing harm to yourself or others please let Tasha, Nic or Kerry know as soon as possible.



Getting to Weave

The venue is located at 1B Elizabeth St, Waterloo NSW 2017.

We will meet you at the front door, which is on Elizabeth St. Car parking is in surrounding streets. The building looks like:



30m to the right of these stairs is a long asphalt ramp with an incline to get to the front door. There is slight – around 1/2cm – uneven ground between the driveway and the road.

We will be outside.

Where we will be is wheelchair accessible and, apart from the inclined ramp up, it will be flat and concrete.

We will be providing lunch, snacks, and water at the event. You can take what you need whenever you need it. This is a drug and alcohol free event.

There's an outdoor smoking area near where we will be.

The event will not be scent-free.

Toilets

There are accessible bathrooms inside Weave and outside in the park.

There are 2 toilets inside Weave.

One toilet is wheelchair accessible. The cubicle doesn't have an automatic door and will need to be opened via a handle. The toilet has hand rails. There is a shower in the toilet cubicle.



Chill Out Room

There is a room with a door and some couches that will be used as a chill-out space where people can take some time out. You can take some time out whenever you need it. There will be some colouring books in there too.

There is also plenty of outdoor space if you need a breather.
