## **School Schedule**

I recommend setting up your wifi connection for both kids on Wednesday night and having the kids show you how to access Clever, Zoom, and all the other apps. Ask them to be the teacher.

## **Thursday and Friday: Virtual School**

### **Overview**

Log both kids into Clever, or ask them to show you how to do this. If you type "Clever" in the browser, it should open for them. If they have to login again, click on the google email and it will log you in.

8:20 a.m. Log into Clever

8:25 a.m. Log into Zoom (link found in teacher room in Clever). Both kids know how to do this, so please ask them.

8:30 a.m. School begins. They will immediately sit down and ask for a snack and a drink even if you just fed them a huge breakfast.

**Note**: The teachers will give periodic breaks throughout the day. You need to keep an eye on the computers for when the break concludes. Both kids will walk away and will be late coming back. If their headphones are connected, you also won't hear the teacher.

# **Monday: Asynchronous School**

#### What to Pack / What Not to Pack

#### **Pack**

- Second grader needs her computer and charger. Kindergartner needs his tablet.
   Both need to be fully charged. We put them in their bags in the morning before we leave.
- Water bottles
- Masks

#### **Don't Pack**

- Headphones. They have headphones at school for them.
- Lunch, snack, etc. They get all meals provided for them.

### **Daily Symptom Check**

In the morning, perform the virtual daily symptom check.

Instructions from School: The school day begins prior to your arrival at school. Each parent/guardian must complete the **Daily Symptom Checklist** prior to boarding the school bus or beginning your carpool. You must have your student's Google ID for the symptom checklist. 

Cohort A will attend on Tuesday and Wednesday and Cohort B will attend on Thursday and Friday. The emailed version is attached <u>here</u>. When in doubt of a cold or sniffles, please keep your child home and log on virtually.

### **Drop-off**

7:50/8:00: Leave the house

8:10: Drop off starts at 8:10 a.m.

We drive them to school. Plan to leave the house by 7:50 or 8:00 latest. They allow kids to be dropped off starting at 8:10. You stay in the car when you drop them off and pick them up.



# Pick-up

3:00: Pick-up starts at 3. I recommend bringing a snack. #hangry
