

Dear Hedke Families,

As we prepare for summer break, we want to inform you that all Chromebooks—*with the exception of those assigned to 5th grade students*—will be sent home for the summer. These devices will allow students continued access to i-Ready Math and Reading lessons through **August 8, 2025**.

Please note the following important information:

- **Internet Safety:** When a Chromebook is connected to home or public Wi-Fi, the school's internet filter is not active. This means students may be able to access websites that are normally restricted at school.
- **Usage Monitoring:** Inappropriate use of the device will still generate alerts, and the school will be notified.
- **Purpose:** These devices are intended to support academic learning over the summer. We encourage you to monitor your child's use to ensure it remains focused on educational activities.
- **Storage Option:** If you choose not to allow your child to use the Chromebook over the summer, we recommend storing it in a safe and secure location.
- **Responsibility:** Families remain responsible for the Chromebook while it is at home, just as they are during the school year.
