Our backline requirements will vary greatly, depending on the country, city, location and timing of your show, and the travel involved to get there. In every case, some of these items may be provided by the band so please confirm the specific requirements of your show directly: mgmt@1032music.com.

III LYLE: KEYS / SYNTHS III

VENUE TO IDEALLY PROVIDE - EVERY SHOW:

- 1 x adjustable piano / drum stool
- 1 x heavy duty keyboard stand
- 2 x stereo or 4 x mono DI boxes
- 1 x monitor wedge

VENUE MAY ALSO NEED TO PROVIDE (ESPECIALLY NON-UK SHOWS):

- 1 x Nord Stage 2 (or comparable)
 - Weighted, 88 keys, Stereo DI.
 - Suitable options (in order of preference):
 - Nord Stage 3, Nord Stage 2, Nord Stage, Nord Electro 6
 - Additional 1 x heavy duty keyboard stand

PLEASE CONFIRM WHETHER THIS WILL NEED TO BE PROVIDED.

🎤 BRIDGET: VOCALS / KEYS 🎤

VENUE TO IDEALLY PROVIDE - EVERY SHOW:

- 2 x boom mic stands
- 2 x XLR cables
- 2 x keyboard stands
- 3 x stereo or 6 x mono DI boxes
- 1 x vocal mic (SM58 or above)
- 1 x monitor wedge

PLEASE NOTE - the band will likely bring:

- 1 x Audix OM7 (run through TC Helicon unit below)
- 1 x TC Helicon VLT2 voice effects unit (XLR out)
- 1 x Nord Electro 6D (DI)
- 1 x Roland SP404-SX (DI)
- 1 x Korg Minilogue XD (DI)

If required, the band may also bring:

Shure PSM 300 IEM system, which will require the appropriate frequency licence to be used at your venue / event

🥁 RADO: DRUMS / PERCUSSION 🥁

VENUE TO PROVIDE - EVERY SHOW:

- 1 x 4-piece Gretsch or Yamaha kit or comparable (bass drum, snare, rack tom & floor tom)
- 1 x power source in close proximity to the kit
- Hardware (drummer will provide breakables):
 - o 1 x drum stool, 2 x snare stands, 1 x hi-hat stand, 4 x cymbal stands, 1 x kick pedal
- All required drum mics (overheads, hi-hat, bass drum, 2 x snare mics, rack tom, floor tom)
- 1 x monitor wedge

🎸 IZZY: BASS GUITAR + VOCALS 🎸

VENUE TO PROVIDE - EVERY SHOW:

- Ideal setups (or equivalent), in order of preference:
 - 1. Vanderkley Spartan Bass Head, Vanderkley 210 MNT, Vanderkley 112 MNT, Avalon U5 DI box
 - 2. MarkBass Little Mark 800 Head, Markbass 410 Cab
 - 3. Aguilar TH350 head, Aguilar 112 Cab (minimum quality)
- 1 x DI box, plus amplifier needs to be mic'd as well
- 1 x monitor wedge
- 1 x boom mic stand
- 1 x SM58 or similar

MONITORS


Minimum 4 wedge monitors with 4 separate mixes, plus one stereo feed for IEMs with approved frequency if required.

ENGINEER(S)

At least one competent, English-speaking, sober and amenable engineer who is familiar with all elements of the system should be present to mix / monitor for the band throughout load-in, sound check, changeover and show.

FRONT OF HOUSE SYSTEMS

A well-maintained PA system that is at least four-way stereo, capable of producing 115dbA +/-2dB at all points in the venue space, clear and undistorted.



BACKSTAGE FACILITIES



We ideally require a secure backstage area / green room on site, with seating for up to six people, adequate lighting, a full-length mirror and access to a bathroom. Bonus points for tea/coffee making facilities with herbal tea and non-dairy milk, and extra bonus points for nutritious vegan backstage snacks!

Safe and secure storage for all our equipment will need to be provided for when we are not on stage, and transport assistance may be required, if the stage is not easily accessible.





We have 3 vegans + 1 x omnivore in our band, and may be travelling with 2-3 other quest artists / crew. We like natural wine, mezcal, tequila, ginger beer, CBD drinks, coconut water, fresh juices and smoothies. The Please confirm the hospitality and rider requirements as agreed between the band and the booking agent(s) - these will no doubt be outlined in any applicable contracts.
