School Health Services JLC

The purpose of health service in the school is to help each child attend school in optimum health and to benefit from the school experience.

First aid and other non-routine measures are initiated by a nurse whenever possible, but may be provided by staff or administration in their absence or unavailability.

First aid at the school or school-sanctioned trips is limited to comfort and protection of the individual until medical evaluation and recommendation is secured. In severe cases requiring prompt medical attention, the school will call emergency services and reach out to emergency contacts as soon as possible. If parents or guardians cannot be reached immediately and an emergency exists, the school will take necessary steps to provide medical attention but will place the financial responsibility for all expenses incurred upon the parents or guardian.

In cases of illness or non-emergency situations, parents or guardians will be notified by the school and the parents or guardian will be responsible for making all transportation arrangements from the school or school-sanctioned trips and provide any medical attention the parent or guardian deems necessary.

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
