All first round testing will be administered onsite

You may compete in 3 events at SLC but they must be in different clusters. Example 1 Skilled event (Health Professions events or Emergency Preparedness events) and 1 Knowledge test (Health Science events) and 1 Soft Skills event (Leadership or Teamwork events). You may also do unlimited recognition events and ATC/NGL Tests at the cost of \$10 per test.

- **MUST HAVE 3 COMPETITORS IN A DIVISION TO RUN AN EVENT AT SLC**
- **YOU MUST ACHIEVE 70% OF THE HIGHEST SCORE IN YOUR EVENT TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BUMP UP LIST FOR ILC**
- **CO HOSA WILL NOT SHIP AWARDS TO PARTICIPANTS WHO DID NOT ATTEND AWARD CEREMONIES AT SLC OR ILC.**
- **STUDENTS COMPETING AT THE COLORADO HOSA STATE LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE WILL SELECT THEIR COMPETITIVE EVENTS BASED ON THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION.**



REQUIREMENT-2027 SLC

Health Science Events

- Students can compete in only **1** Health Science event (Knowledge exams)

Skilled Events (ex: Emergency Preparedness and Health Professions)

- Students may compete in **1** Skilled event. The 1 Skilled event a student selects must be in either one of these two clusters.

Leadership Events and Teamwork Events (ex: Prepared Speaking and HOSA Bowl)

- Students may compete in **1** competitive event from one of these two buckets.
- We strongly encourage students to participate in one skilled event, one leadership or teamwork event and 1 knowledge test in order to best enhance their State Leadership Conference experience.

Recognition Events

- Students can compete in as many Recognition Events as they would like.

NGL/ATC Testing Events

- Students can take as many tests as they wish for a cost of \$10 each.

NOTE: Not including Recognition Events, a student should not be registered for more than 3 events at the HOSA SLC and those 3 events **must align to the statements above**.

Round One Testing will be completed onsite at state conference

- Students will choose which events they wish to participate in that align to the above criteria and *will all attend SLC*
- Round 2 qualifiers will be posted after first-round competitions are completed and scores are tabulated at SLC.
