Faith Like A Centurion Matthew 8:5–13

Big Idea: The kingdom of God doesn't belong to those who think they've earned it — it

belongs to those who know they haven't and trust in Jesus alone to welcome them in.
1. Faith Begins with Humility
2. Faith rests in Christ alone
3. Faith secures a seat at God's Table
3. Taltil secures a seat at God's Table
<i>Questions for Reflection:</i> 1. Do you come to God with a sense of humility and dependence or thinking you've earned His
favor? What would it look like to approach God empty-handed this week?

2. Jesus welcomes outsiders into His kingdom. Who in your life might feel like they are too far

from God, and how can you reflect God's welcoming grace to them this week?

Discipleship Helpsheet

Heidelberg Catechism (On the Ten Commandments)

Question 108: What is God's will for us in the seventh commandment?

Answer: That God condemns all unchastity, and that therefore we should thoroughly detest it and live decent and chaste lives, within or outside of the holy state of marriage.

(Lev. 18:30; Matt. 5:27-32; 1 Cor. 6:18-20; Eph. 5:3-5)

Question 109: Does God, in this commandment, forbid only adultery and similar shameful sins?

Answer: Since we, body and soul, are temples of the Holy Spirit, it is God's will that we keep ourselves pure and holy. Therefore, God forbids all unchaste actions, looks, talk, thoughts, or desires, and whatever may incite someone to them.

(Matt. 5:27-30; 1 Cor. 6:12-20; Eph. 5:3-4)
