Given the complex and rapidly changing global context in which EFM operates, the spiritual gifts of wisdom and discernment are essential for understanding cultural dynamics and faithfully communicating the unchanging truths of the gospel in relevant ways.

Demonstrating vision to discern new areas of ministry, compelled by the desire to fulfill the Great Commission, the Executive Director must encourage a global perspective and mobilize followers of Jesus to extend His kingdom beyond their immediate contexts.

The Executive Director must be a developer of people in order to maximize the strengths of the staff and the organization to accomplish the mission. Additionally, the Executive Director must be a developer of resources, with the ability to raise funds to further the mission.
