

T/4 Douglas W. Kundiger, 116 Garfield avenue, was with headquarters and service company, 553rd engineer heavy pontoon company, and was awarded the American theater service ribbon, ETO service ribbon with four bronze stars and good conduct medal. He joined the service Jan. 28, 1943.

Chief Tester Dies at Home

Douglas W. Kundiger, 40, of 116 Crane Ave., died today at 3 a.m. at his home, following a heart attack:

He was born July 11, 1917, in Oshkosh, son of Mr. and Mrs. Rexford H. Kundiger. He attended Campus School and graduated from Oshkosh High School. On Sept. 21, 1940, he was married to Miss Irene Hitchcock.

Mr. Kundiger served in World War II from 1942-45 as a sergeant with the Third Army in Europe. He had been employed by U.S. Motors Corporation as chief tester. He was a member of Algoma Boulevard Methodist Church.

Surviving are his wife, Irene; his parents who reside in Oshkosh; six daughters, Judith, Deanne, Nancy, Susan, Dale and Kay at home; one brother, Wayne B. Kundiger, Beaver Dam; two sisters, Mrs. Arthur Last, Garden City, Mich., and Mrs. Irving A. Radtke, Oshkosh; and several nieces and nephews.
