

Lockdown Browser

- The Respondus Lockdown Browser that is included as part of the Mastery Connect subscription comes with different levels of security.
- The default security level is Very High.
- Lockdown browser must be set at the district level, it cannot be set at the school level.
- Lockdown browser can currently be used on all devices, including Chromebooks.

Levels of Security:

- Low:
 - The browser is initially at the “low” security level. This level blocks access to other applications, but does not restrict navigation to course tools like chat and search boxes.
- Medium:
 - The medium level is used for quiz score review pages and other protected content that should not be copy-pasted or printed. The browser maximizes the current page in a new window, blocking access to links and tools on the page under it. Navigation is allowed for any links on the protected page, and the student is allowed to close the page.
- Medium High:
 - The medium high security level mirrors the behavior of High security, with the exception that the user is able to close the browser during an exam with a confirmation prompt.
- High:
 - The high security level is “quiz mode”, the page is maximized and students are not allowed to close the page or exit the browser until the server signals the browser that the quiz has been completed. The High security page allows the student to use refresh during an assessment.
 - To end high security and allow students to close the browser, without submitting the assessment, use a JavaScript command or navigation with CGI variable to change the security level to Medium or Low, or issue the close browser command.
- Very High:
 - The Very High security level has all of the aspects of the High security, however, the refresh button is blocked.
