***Part I – Directions for Becoming Naomi Leon and Shakespeare’s Secret
Word Study/Vocabulary***

1. Read *Becoming Naomi Leon* (BNL) and *Shakespeare’s Secret* (SS) before returning to school in September.
2. When reading the books, circle or highlight any words that you are unable to define.
3. Create a list of these words. Make a note of the page number on which the word appears.
4. Using a dictionary, find the part of speech and a definition for each word. If the word has multiple definitions, use the one that fits the word as it is used in context in the book.
5. You must have a minimum of 20 words per book on your list.

Example:

1. rabble (n)- (p.1)- a large noisy uncontrolled group; a mob

Analytical Reading

1. Read *Becoming Naomi Leon* (BNL) and *Shakespeare’s Secret* (SS) before returning to school in September.
2. For each of these two books, you are expected to complete the prewriting/graphic organizers that are attached.
3. These must be completed before you return to school. They will be collected in English class.

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Graphic Organizer for *Becoming Naomi Leon*

Create a chart (in note form) that contains the following information:

- identify at least four relationships Naomi has with others in the novel
- briefly describe each relationship

EXAMPLE- (write in note form only)

Relationship	Description of the relationship
Naomi and the school librarian	Welcomes Naomi into his student group; provides a haven for Naomi in school; understands that Naomi has a difficult family life

Graphic Organizer for *Shakespeare's Secret*

Create a chart (in note form) that contains the following information:

- identify at least four significant relationships Danny has with others in the novel
- briefly describe each relationship

EXAMPLE- (write in note form only)

Relationship	Description of the relationship
Danny and Aaron's brother, Ben (p.54-5)	sometimes the boys are friends, but other times Danny doesn't care for Ben's behavior
