Students must submit an LPN Transition to ADN (DAY) program application to the Health Sciences Admissions Coordinator by November 1st for consideration of admission in the following spring semester (March entry). To be eligible for a program application, the student must meet the following criteria:

- Students must be eligible for enrollment in ENG 111 and MAT 171
- Have taken or are currently enrolled in BIO 168, CHM 130, and CHM 130A
- The student's overall grade point average must be 2.0 or higher
- Evidence of a current unencumbered LPN license

A minimum grade of "C" is required for non-NUR courses, and a minimum grade of "B" is required for NUR courses
