



Crafting Change Wristers by Melanie Shovelski

Materials:

Size H (5mm) Crochet Hook
Worsted Weight (4 Medium) Yarn
Darning or Blunt Needle

Wristers (make 2)

Body:

Chain 21 (about 5.5-6 in)
Row 1: HDC in the 2nd chain from the hook and in each chain across
Row 2: Chain 1 - Turn - HDC across
Repeat row until each piece measures about 7-7.5 inches

Edging:

At the end of your last row - chain 1- DO NOT TURN - sc evenly down the length of the rectangle - ch 1 - sc across - do not fasten off (see below for options)

Finish: Fold wrister in half, sc both edges together the next 6 stitches - slip stitch the 6 stitches along one side only - sc remainder of both edges together.
Fasten off.
Weave in ends.

Hands come in many sizes, adjust as needed for your hands :)

Optional Edging:

- Crochet the last sc row in a CC
- Replace the second sc row with a row of mini shells
