Course Description:

Chorus students will learn to use their vocal instrument to create a correct and pleasing singing sound. In addition to learning proper vocal production and technique, students will also learn music reading skills, sight-singing skills, and performance skills.

Class Objectives:

- CREATE: Students will conceptualize, generate and organize artistic ideas and work. They will complete and refine musical works.
- PERFORM: Students will analyze, interpret, and select artistic work for performance. They will develop
 techniques and concepts to refine artistic work, and express meaning through the presentation of musical works.
- RESPOND: Students will perceive and analyze artistic work and process. They will interpret intent and meaning, and apply criteria to evaluate artistic work and process
- CONNECT: Students will synthesize and relate knowledge from personal and collaborative experience to make
 and receive art. They will relate artistic ideas and works with societal, cultural, and historical context to deepen
 understanding
- To Become RESPONSIBLE & RESPECTFUL citizens in society.

RULES & EXPECTATIONS:

- BE PREPARED- Get your music folder/tablet and other required materials upon entering the class
- BE ON TIME- Prepared and in your seat before the bell rings.
- SING- Have good posture and sing

Grading Policy-

PARTICIPATION/ATTITUDE -- Choir is a "hands on" learning class so students will be graded on their participation in class. Each day students can earn up to 10 points.

1 point for being on time

1 point for being prepared

1 point for correct singing posture

7 points for on task behavior (singing, limited talking, participation)

TESTS- There may be a test at the end of each quarter and the possibility of more in between. Tests are a good opportunity for students to find out what they know and where they need to improve on. If they are not satisfied with the score, the student may retake the test and I will take the higher score.

SINGING TESTS- If needed you will be tested how well you can sing the music. You will record yourself singing the music and then upload and send the file to me through e-mail or canvas.

PERFORMANCE - A performance is like a final exam, you must be there to perform, "take the test", or you will not get any credit for the performance. Unfortunately illnesses or other important events may occur which may make it impossible for you to attend the concert. If something prevents you from attending the concert I must receive notice 2 <u>WEEKS BEFORE</u> if possible, the concert explaining the reason for missing the concert signed and dated by a parent/guardian. There will be a concert excuse form that you can get from me to fill out. If you miss a performance you will be given the opportunity to make it up with an assignment equivalent to the performance. If I don't receive notification 2 weeks prior to the concert you will not get full credit.

Homework and Late Work Policy:

Assignments will be given to help students practice the knowledge they are learning in class. They are due the next day unless told otherwise. Larger assignments will be given in advance and students will have weeks to prepare them. I will have deadlines for late work and after that I will not accept it, so please be aware of when the deadlines are so you can turn in your assignments.
