1	Elaboration includes three or fewer accurate facts to describe slavery, freedom and the time period.	Elaboration is not persuasive. The reasons provided do not support the speaker's idea or supporting reasons are not present.	Elaboration has many errors throughout. The spelling and grammatical errors interfere with the understanding of the elaboration.
