



ISSUES IN DEVELOPMENT: SUSTAINABILITY

In today's lesson, you will be producing a set of notes by writing down four main statements and then adding any details you can find to them. For this exercise, you will be using the following textbook:

Robert Murphy and Charles Gleek, <u>Global Politics</u>, Pearson Education: London, 2016, pp. 60-63.

The four main statements all focus on the idea of sustainability and its role in development. They are as follows:

- 1. "Countries in the Northern Hemisphere are considered more prosperous and powerful. Countries in the Southern Hemisphere have to obey rules set by those in the North and this can inhibit their development.
- 2. "Globalization can mean traditional gender roles are questioned. This is particularly true for the association of masculinity with privilege."
- 3. "Issues such as illiteracy, migration, sexual violence and disease continue to have a different impact on men, women and children because of different cultural norms."
- 4. "The Three Pillars of Sustainability should not be seen in isolation. They interact with one another."
