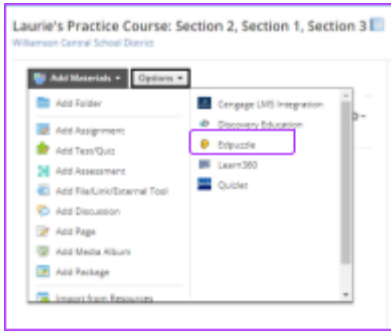


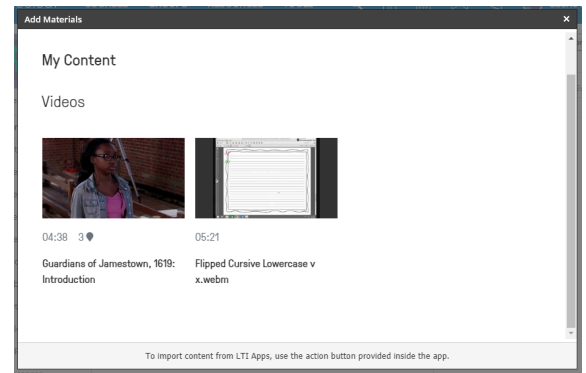
Connecting to Students to EdPuzzle Through Schoology

- By connecting to Edpuzzle assignments through Schoology, students do not need to login into Edpuzzle separately
- When set up, Edpuzzle will import student grades directly to Schoology gradebook.
- Before beginning this step, add content, create questions, edit the video (All in the quick start guide above)



1. Click on Edpuzzle under add materials tab.

2. A pop up will open showing your content. Select the video that you would like to assign to your students. Click on the "eye" icon that says watch and click blue **ASSIGN** button
3. Make choices regarding skipping and closed caption and click **ASSIGN** once again.
4. Your assignment will then be added to your materials page

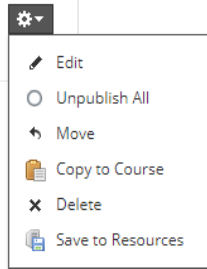
