- 2) The successful applicant must have successfully completed at least six CSEC subjects at Cornwall College and have been accepted to enter the Sixth Form CAPE programme at the school;
- 3) Applicant must have demonstrable and verifiable financial need;
- 4) Applicant must have a record of co-curricular involvement, whether at the school or in his community.
- 5) Applicant must have no record of indiscipline at the school.
- 6) Applicant must have attended Cornwall College for at least 3 years prior to date of application
