2025 APNM Electronic and Multimedia Call for Works

<u>The Association for the Promotion of New Music (APNM)</u> welcomes the submission of new and existing works in the following categories:

- 1. Composer-performer with interactive live electronics and/or multimedia
- 2. Fixed or interactive media electronic works with 1-2 performers
- 3. Fixed media solo (up to 4-channel spatialization)

for a concert at Mise-en Place in New York City on November 15, 2025.

Selected composers are encouraged to attend the performance. We regret that we are unable to provide travel assistance. Works for any combination of the following forces are welcome: mixed acoustic and electronic works for live performer and multimedia; multichannel works with up to 4 channels of surround sound; support for fixed media, real-time electronics, or flexible media; works that include video and film projection, works for diffusion; improvisatory works involving available technologies; modular synthesis, instrument building, circuit bending, and other forms. Bold, daring, genre-bending, and shape-shifting works are welcome!

We anticipate limited funds to pay performers but plan to evaluate submissions on a case-by-case basis, and if there is enough demand for any particular instrument, we will aim to support funding towards a performer of that instrument. Composers may submit existing pieces or representative works accompanied by proposals for new pieces.

APNM and Mise-en_Place can furnish the following equipment:

- 1 x mixing console
- 4 x loudspeakers for quad spatialization/diffusion (front and back pairs of speakers)
- 1 x central laptop to run playback, patches, and other software
- 1 x projector and screen with HDMI compatibility
- TRS and XLR cabling on site
- 1-2 x condenser microphones

Composers will be asked to submit technical riders and should plan to furnish any additional requirements beyond the PA system outlined above.

Please submit the following by 11:59pm EST on September 15, 2025:

- 1. **Links** to submitted or representative score with recording **or** proposal for performance with representative audio recording. For non-traditional or score-free works, include a link to a description of your artistic process that resulted/will result in your piece.
- 2. If submitting a representative work (rather than an existing piece intended for performance), a **proposal for a new work** to be featured on the concert.
- 3. Brief **Biography** and **Program Note** (up to 200 words)
- 4. Link to a complete or evolving **Technical Rider**, or a simple description or list of your technical needs. (Riders that include stage plots and audio connections are encouraged wherever possible.)

We anticipate informing selected composers by **October 1**. Incomplete applications cannot be considered.
