Mishawaka High School (MHS) partners with the Elkhart Area Career Center (EACC) to provide Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway opportunities *beyond the CTE Programs currently available at MHS.*

- MHS students may attend PM sessions only at the EACC. **EACC Session: 12:00pm to 2:45pm**
 - If accepted, the EACC classes will replace a student's 3rd and 4th block classes each day.
 - EACC Programs are a full year commitment. Students may not withdraw from the EACC midyear.
 - Year 1 of EACC coursework includes the full Career Technical Educator (CTE) Pathway sequence: Principles, Concentrator A, Concentrator B.
- Students must be on track to graduate with excellent attendance and no credit recovery needed.
- ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO RIDE MHS BUS TO & FROM EACC.
 - Attendance will be taken daily. Students may not drive independently.
 - **EACC Session: 12:00pm to 2:45pm**
 - LOADING starts at 11:15 AM MHS Bus departs promptly at 11:30 AM. from the Southwest Corner of MHS parking lot.
 - EXCEPTION: Cosmetology & Barbering students sign *waiver* for independent transportation due to extended hours.

MHS Students may only apply to take classes at the EACC if the CTE Pathway is unavailable at Mishawaka.
