Serve as guide and role model for scholars:

- Help build and uphold an environment for learning that invites and excites scholar learning
- Live and model Catalyst's core values with scholars and their families
- Empower scholars to access their voices and leadership
- Support the day-to-day happenings of the school
- Manage student behavior according to common Catalyst practices

Commit to your professional learning and growth

- Collaborate with Lead Teachers and the Support Services Team to provide small and large group instruction and 1:1 support to uphold classroom expectations and culture when filling in for an absence
- Authentically engage in Catalyst's culture of adult learning and professional development
- Invest in personal professional development by demonstrating a willingness to be coached during bi-weekly feedback sessions

Targeted Scholar Support

- Provide support to individual scholars, small groups of scholars, and large groups of scholars during instructional classes as well as during lunch, recess, and other parts of the day.
- With guidance from and in collaboration with coaches, Lead Teachers, and the Support Services Team, teach small groups and lead intervention for targeted scholars as needed
- Meet with the teams that you support as needed and support the Operations Team initiatives
- With support from the Support Services Team, a coach and Lead Teachers, assist scholars with special needs in the areas of educational concern.
- Perform supervisory duties while scholars are at play
- Provide assistance in any lunch administration activities such as escorting scholars to lunch as well as to play areas, assist in cleaning for lunch areas

Support the organizational culture of our school community:

- Uphold all professional responsibilities, including maintaining excellent attendance and punctuality and uphold professional norms of decorum
- Support the ongoing day to day operations of the school, as needed
- Provide coverage across the school, as needed, particularly for lunch, recess, or other times
- Other duties, as assigned
