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# SRC

## (Student Representative Council)

SRC members will be a voice for their peers and work as a direct link between the ideas and concerns of students and school leadership in order to take action to better the school. They will model the school values in all they do and advocate for positive change with their role. SRC members will actively engage with school improvement, working towards ideas and projects that improve the school environment in terms of academic learning, wellbeing, and engagement & enthusiasm in school. They will listen to feedback from fellow students and bring forward ideas, concerns, initiatives, and improvements, leading projects to address these collaboratively with fellow students, teachers, and school leadership.

### ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend regular meetings as an SRC to share ideas, concerns, and improvements
- Make decisions about school life (e.g., lunchtime activities, school events, significant days)
- Lead homegroup meetings with students to gather ideas and feedback from their year group
- Engage with the community to develop and promote local partnerships and opportunities for students at each year level
- Present to school staff on initiatives to be undertaken
- Contribute to the improvement in teaching and learning at the school, providing feedback to teachers and presenting information about how students in your year group learn best
- Contribute to the design of processes and policies that make the school function better (e.g., how students access wellbeing; the consequence process for behaviour concerns; the design and delivery of teaching and learning across the school)
