Environment Protection (Beverage Container Deposit and Recovery Scheme) Bill 2021

The purpose of this Bill is to provide for the environmentally sustainable use of resources and best practice in waste management by establishing a national beverage container deposit and recovery scheme. It is 10c for each beverage that is deposited, unless stated otherwise.
