ROOM RESERVATIONS:

One change to our room reservations this year is that all attendees are responsible for making their hotel reservations *through Hammock Beach Resort*. The special conference rates listed below for hotel suites is applicable up to 3 days prior to conference and up to 3 days after the conference.

The deadline to reserve a room for the Called Worker conference is Friday, September 13th. We can not guarantee a room or the price below if you make a reservation after the deadline.

If your church/school is located in Florida, you can take advantage of your tax-exempt status. Here is how:

For individual guests who are travelling as part of their church/school that has a Florida State Tax Exemption Certificate, the Resort will honor tax exemption *if the church/school is paying for the reservation*. In other words, as long as the payment from the tax-exempt church/school *matches* the tax-exempt certificate received from the church/school, we can honor tax exemption. A guest may *not* pay on his/her own "personal" credit card and show the tax-exempt certificate. The payment received must match the tax-exempt organization.

It is recommended that guests who would like to be tax exempt for their stay contact our Reservations Team *directly*, so our Reservations Team can collect the tax exemption paperwork in advance, confirm the payment match, and then set up the reservation billing to run correctly as tax exempt.
