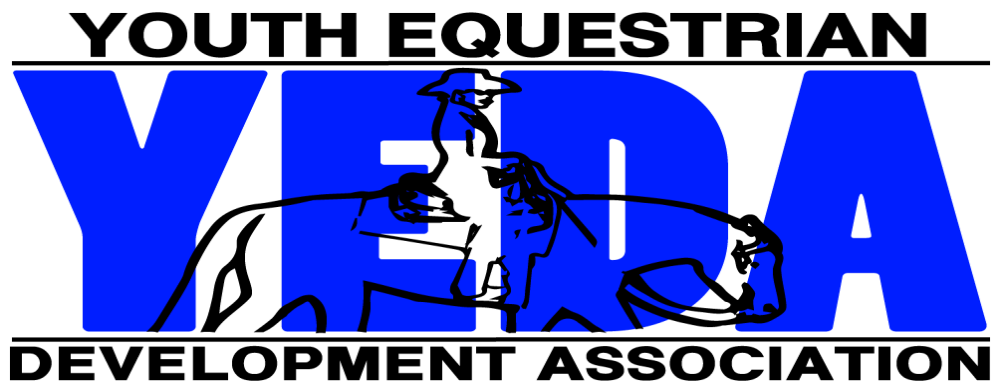

YEDA Collegiate Celebration Important Information and Rules

- Arrival time/check in time is Thursday, May 12th after 3:00pm. If you need to arrive prior to this time, please contact Laura Smith at 419-957-9054
- Schooling of horses will begin at 4:00pm to ??.
- Camping is available on the grounds. 30amp service is available for \$40/night and 50amp service is available for \$50/night. Please stop in the office prior to parking and a spot will be assigned to you based on your needs. Please provide type of unit, length, type of service required and license plate number.
- The link to the live program will be on the YEDA website, www.showyeda.com under the shows and events tab (2021-2022 show schedule). Click on the show dates and then "live program". Friday after the show, scoresheets will be available for review. They will also be uploaded to the website and can be found on the same page as the live program.

1. In both the individual and team Level 2 Ranch Riding a rider may post or stand at the extended trot with no penalty. There will be a 5-point penalty assessed if the rider holds the saddle horn.

2. Overall team points will be calculated like a regular season IHSA show. First place will receive 7 points, second place 5 points, third place 4 points, fourth place 3 points, fifth place 2 points, and sixth place 1 point. We will only add the top 6 class scores for each team allowing every team to have a drop score.

3. In the event of a tie for the overall team standings the tie will be broken. We will use the following method to break team standings ties. The team with the highest number of first place points will win the tie. If there is still a tie the team with the highest number of second place points will win the tie. If there is still a tie the team with the highest placing in the team reining class will win the tie.

4. Spur Rule: Beginner Horsemanship Division: NO SPURS

Rookie, Level 1 and Level 2 Horsemanship Divisions: Ball Spur only if horse provider approves

Open Division: Ball or Rowell Spurs only if horse provider approves

Ranch Riding Divisions: Ball Spurs only if horse provider approves

Reining Division: Ball or Rowell Spurs only if horse provider approves

5. The show will be using AQHA Score sheets. All scoresheets will be posted at the end of the show.

6. All re-rides and re-tests will follow the current IHSA rulebook.

7. If a situation presents itself that is not clearly defined it will be decided upon by the show steward committee using the IHSA rulebook as their guidelines

2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large fast circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation.
6. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence - no hesitation.
7. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least 10 feet. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.

1. Beginning, lope straight up the left side of the arena, circle the top end of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
2. Continue straight up the right side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
3. Continue up the left side of the arena to the center marker. At the center marker, the horse should be on the right lead. Guide the horse to the center of the arena on the right lead and complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads in the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Continue up the left side of the arena, circle the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. Dixie (MTSU) – Can be as educated as you ask her to be. Push her where you want, don't pull. Very rocky lope. Ball spur optional.
2. Eddie (MTSU) -
3. Gracey (MTSU) – Straight forward reiner. Help keep organized or she will be clumsy. Can get antsy in the middle. Division appropriate spurs optional.
4. Raquel (MTSU) – Nice, soft ride. Will over-cant if you don't support her with both legs. Help her take step forward in turns on haunches. Division appropriate spurs optional.
5. Sweets (MTSU) – Experienced reiner. Can be strong in rundowns and antsy in the middle. Otherwise is very straight forward. Division appropriate spurs optional.
6. Thomas (MTSU) -
7. Colby (Tennessee Tech) – Lower level western horse. Has a spur stop. Division appropriate spurs.
8. Cora (Tennessee Tech) – Grey. Super easy. Set up for leads, very lazy. Division appropriate spurs
9. Treasure (Tennessee Tech) – 15.2h sorrel mare. Sensitive. Ask nicely for transitions. No spurs
10. Winny (Tennessee Tech) – Heavy head. Will need to help hold her up. Very lazy
