SQA Appeals

The SQA offer an appeals service, where candidates can challenge the grade received. This will involve a re-marking of exam papers and coursework, however the SQA will not consider any other evidence such as prelims and class assessments. Appeals can be generated by students through the SQA website, and they will need their SCN. I would strongly advise that students discuss any appeals with their class teachers first. They can advise on component marks, grade boundaries and the potential risks. Please be aware that grades can go down as well as up.

The deadline for appeals is Tuesday, August 27 at 11:59pm

Guardian Summaries

Guardian summaries allow parents to receive regular updates by email of assignments posted to students in their Google classrooms. The summaries allow parents to keep track of any upcoming, late or missing assignments and if you have a Google email account you can also manage the frequency of such updates. To sign up for guardian summaries, students must give consent by filling in the consent form linked below. It is important that they supply an email address which matches the stored e-mail address on your school record. To set this up, follow these steps:Sign into Google using their EduBuzz account. S1 Lockers

Lockers are offered at a cost of £10 per student (£0 for Free School Meal) and remain the responsibility of the students until study leave begins at the end of 6th year or when they leave school. £5 will be returned to the student when they leave school if they return the locker key. Locker contract forms will be issued to students via their registration teachers, on receipt of payment on SchoolPay or if a student is entitled to Free School Meals.

We will get lockers forms for students to complete next week and then we will distribute locker keys in PSE classes in the week beginning 26th August.

The conditions for rental are as follows:-

- Sharing of lockers or swapping of lockers and keys is not allowed
- Loss of locker key should be reported to the office where a replacement locker key will cost £5
- Any wilful damage to the lockers will be paid for by parents/carers
