TITLE	Resolution to Bring Back the Point 2 Point Shuttle Program

WHEREAS, approximately 70% of students attending UCR live off-campus;

WHEREAS, there is increased crime in the areas around UCR, namely <u>assault</u>, <u>property crime</u>, <u>and theft</u>;

WHEREAS, the latest class that is offered on campus ends at 9:50 pm;

WHEREAS, <u>daylight ends and it gets dark earlier</u> (the sun sets at 4:45 pm) as we move closer to the winter months;

WHEREAS, events held by <u>campus organizations</u> do not have a set time for when they should end;

WHEREAS, the <u>UCR housing program recognizes that they are unable to provide housing for all students and faculty</u>. This has lead them to create a <u>UCR off-campus housing listing service</u> that mentions many off-campus housing complexes in partnership with Apartments.com;

WHEREAS, signs around campus and information on the <u>UCR and UCR-affiliated websites</u> have vet to be updated, misleading students to believe that point to point shuttle is still in service;



WHEREAS, the <u>Campus Safety Escort Service</u> (hereinafter referred to as CSES) will only provide students with a volunteer student escort who will walk the student only to campus owned <u>properties</u>: Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That The Associated Students of the University of California, Riverside -

- (1) Will support the introduction of the Point 2 Point Shuttle Program again after its suspension due to the COVID-19 pandemic and UCPD's role in running the program.
- (2) Let It Be Further Resolved that we will use social media, public postings, and other forms of communication to raise awareness of the reinstatement of the Point 2 Point Shuttle Program on campus.
- (3) Let It Be Further Resolved that we will extend our support to UCPD in their efforts to hire UCR students to run the shuttle program.
