## **PRELIMINARY INFORMATION**

**Games are played on console (PS3) or on the original arcade machine. Please bring your own controller or at least arrange someone to lend you their own.**

Currently confirmed highlights: Latvian Tekken 6 champion will be coming to face off against all competition from Finland. SSF4 1st and 2nd place players from Baltic Beatdown face off in an exhibition match.

## **Public events.**

**You are eligible to play in all public events as long as you pay the entry fee for the whole event.**

(if you're more of a serious FG player, check out the High Roller tournament options below, first)

**All Public events are 2v2 team tournaments. Are usually quick single match games and will be one-off singular events. Team members are randomly picked, so even if you're not that good you might get an awesome partner.**

**Anyone who pays the entry fee (TBA) can participate in all of the below.**

**Winning team gets a prize (not money)**

**Teams are determined right before the tournament in question starts.**

**2v2 teams are handled the following way.**

**1) Players on each team determine their order as player1 and player2**

**2) Player1 plays player1 on the opposing team, player2 plays player2. If after these two matches the score is 1:1. Winners of both matches face each other for the tie breaker.**

**At the end of each 2v2 there's a secret event. Both players on a team win a prize each.**

**Super Street Fighter 2 Turbo** - Arcade Machine, 2v2 teams, double elimination. Arcade machine was recently outfitted with high-quality Seimitsu buttons and joysticks.

**Super Street Fighter 4: Arcade Edition** - Team Tournament 2v2 style. Double Elimination.  $\frac{2}{3}$  rounds. 1 match.

**Ultimate Marvel vs Capcom 3** - Team Tournament 2v2 style. Double Elimination ft1 win

**King Of Fighters 13** - Team Tournament. Random teams. 3 people per team. Each player plays 1 character. ft1 win. Double Elimination

**Mortal Kombat** - 2v2 teams, tag-team mode. ft1 win

**Street Fighter X Tekken** - Team Tournament. Random teams. Teams play ft1 win,  $\frac{2}{3}$  rounds. Double Elimination.

**Puzzle Fighter.** Ft1  $\frac{2}{3}$  rounds. Double Elimination.

**Rock Paper Scissors.** Double Elimination. First to 5.

### **High Rollers Events.**

This is for serious players only or for those who wish to try their hand at something more challenging . Participants create the prize pool. Minimum fee 5 euro. Participants can agree on more.

Winnings are 100% - 1st place, 2nd place gets money back.
