HOUSING and GENERAL HELP

<u>Veteran's Community Resource and Referral Center at Fort McPherson</u> 1701 Hardee Ave SW. Atl. 404-230-5683 x397436 during business hours. Go to Lakewood Marta station and take the VA shuttle. Provides housing vouchers, connects people to support agencies, helps with employment. Can go directly. (Reviewed 01-23-25)

<u>National Call Center for Homeless Veterans</u> Call 877-424-3838 if after business hours but they will forward your call to the VCRRC and they will call you back during business hours. (Reviewed 01-23-25)

<u>Central Outreach and Advocacy Center</u> (Central Presbyterian) 201 Washington St. SW. Atl 404-659-7119. (Georgia State Station, across from the Capitol) Phones open at 9:15. Wed. 9-12:30 but come early. First come, first served. Veteran Team every 3rd Monday of each month 9-12:30 Reviewed 12-03-24

<u>Hope Atlanta</u> for Veterans 458 Ponce de Leon Ave. NE Atl. 30308 Bldg B Terrace level. 404-574-1681 404-817-7070. Can go directly there. Help with rental/eviction, utility assistance, HUD-VASH referrals etc. Mon-Fri. 9-4 pm. Reviewed 06-03-25

Mercy Care 678-843-8600 Has transitional housing at Hope House for vets with substance abuse.

PCCI Project Community Connections 404-321-6111 x397436 Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF is a program to assist veterans and their families experiencing homelessness to become rapidly re-housed and self-sufficient.) Must be a single person or in a family with one spouse being a vet. Must have less than 80% of the AMI. Currently residing in emergency shelter, transitional housing or place not meant for human habitation such as car, outside, abandoned building etc. PCCI services cover people in the City of Atlanta, Fulton, DeKalb, Clayton, Henry, Rockdale, Gwinnett and Douglas counties. Veterans could present at the Community Resource and Referral Center (CRRC) to determine eligibility for other agencies. CRRC is at Fort McPherson building 129, 1701 Hardee Ave SW Atl. Vets can also self-refer on the Get Help page of PCCI. Might have to go through the local coordinated entry. Reviewed 07-04-2025

PCCI Veteran's Homeless Prevention Assistance. Go to website and fill out form if you have received a dispossessory warrant, at imminent risk of losing your home in 30 days and have a lease in your name. Reviewed 07-04-2025

Salvation Army Start out by calling 404-486-2870 and ask about the nine month transitional program for vets and their families including case management etc.

<u>Trinity Community Ministries</u> 2900 Landrum Drive 404-222-9015 Men 30&up. Verification of homelessness. Must complete interview before being accepted into program. Two-bedroom apartments at Eagle's Nest complex. Has transitional housing for vets with substance abuse. 404-222-0553

<u>Tunnels to Towers Foundation</u> Fill out application on line. Rooms and supportive services for vets.

<u>UHope CDC</u> 7770 Roswell Rd. Sandy Springs. 470-300-9598;770-9985644 Housing for homeless vets and men over 18.

<u>VASH</u> Veteran's Affairs Supportive Housing Program. For homeless vets with substance abuse and/or mental health issues. Go through your case manager at Hope Atlanta or the VA at Fort McPherson.

<u>Veteran's Empowerment Organization of Georgia Inc.</u> 373 W Lake Ave NW, Atl. 404-889-8710. Provide help with housing. No emergency housing but other types of housing.

PICTURE ID OR ID CARD OR DRIVER'S LICENSE

If you are honorably discharged with active service and if GA was your home of record as shown on your DD-214 or if you can prove you have lived in GA continuously for the last 5 years, you may be eligible to get a free ID or Drivers license. If you have been receiving VA benefits or treatment at the VA hospital in GA or have had a bank account or been employed or can otherwise show you have lived in GA for the last 5 years continuously, you should call or visit the GA Dept. of Veterans Affairs at 730 Peachtree St. 404-347-3484

For men 21 & up, who are veterans, alcohol and substance abusers, and ex-offenders (first priority) Must have photo ID, psychological evaluation, and background check. House adults for up to a year. Offer special services for veterans. Wheelchair accessible in certain locations (Decatur). 5 locations 6 beds each.

<u>Hope For Haven House</u> 3027 Memorial Dr. Atl. 404-594-2029 This is a paid home-maybe \$900 to get in plus monthly rent of the same. Includes utilities. For vets and recovering individuals.

Independent Living House 4087 Emerald North Dr. Decatur 770-875-1335 Men and women on different floors. \$675 monthly. Also washer and dryer. Reviewed 08-18-25.
