Zaption	Zaption is a web app for teachers, trainers, and content publishers to use video as an interactive experience. Add images, text, quizzes and discussions to private videos as well as those from YouTube and Vimeo to create a “learning tour.”
Web-Based Audio	There are many sites that have Cloze-type activities for students to complete based on an audio file or video. This is one example in French.
CLEAR Cloze	RIA (Rich Internet Applications) are free programs managed by the Center for Language Education And Research at Michigan State University. The goal of the Rich Internet Applications project is to create tools that are informed by language acquisition research, and engage language learners in active learning. Using their Rich Internet Applications toolset, you can incorporate interpretative as well as speaking activities into your language class through technology to reduce preparation and grading and increase student motivation.
