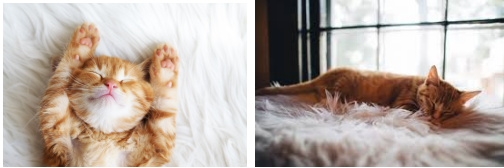
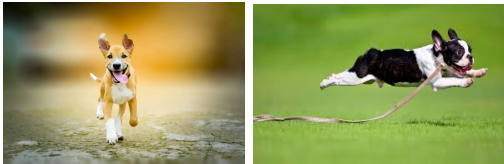


Week 5
