

Parent/Guardian Directions: How to submit a video work sample

If a student wants to submit a video for their work sample, this is fine. Here are some things to include. Your CST can help you with this as well.

1. Create a Google Doc ([docs.new](https://docs.google.com/new))
2. Add the normal LP and student information on the Doc
 - Name, LP #, date, subject
3. Add a hyperlink of the video to the Doc
 - Paste video URL or Google Drive link
 - **Make sure the video is shared to anyone with the link**
 - (Add screenshot of the video or CST can do this)
4. Write a blurb describing what the video shows
5. Share Doc with your CST

Example of what a video work sample submission could look like:

Shawnee Doe

LP3
Social Studies
11/4/24

This LP, Shawnee learned about catapults. Shawnee worked on a Kiwi crate to build a catapult. We also researched about catapults, the materials they used to be made of, the scale factor (how big the original catapults were) and what civilizations used catapults. The video shows Shawnee making the catapult and talking about the cultures that used them.
