Important Information

- Students will work in a group to create a music video teaching a grammar concept in English.
 - o Step 1: With your group, choose a grammar topic and a popular song.
 - o Step 2: Change the lyrics in the song to explain the grammar concept.
 - o Step 3: Film a music video with your group members.
 - o Step 4: Edit the music video and present it to the class.
- The video must be completely in English.
- The video mustn't contain any inappropriate language or content for school.
- Students will bring the video to class on a pendrive to share with the class.

Use of English	The grammar concept it explained correctly, and the use of English in the song's lyrics is correct.
