Our rowing shell was heading to the East bay, following our usual traffic pattern and staying close to the South shore. A Red & White Ski boat with a skier was heading to the West bay also on the South shore. They approached us head on at speed. It actually looked like he made a move towards us rather than make a turn and head back eastwards. I had to stop the boat when I realized he either couldn't see us or just didn't care. He was a good 400ft away when I stopped the boat. I was in the cox seat, and was waving to let him know we were directly in front of him. All rowers were wearing hi-viz clothing. He made a very sharp turn under 150 feet from our bow. This of course threw a big wake our way. Thankfully due to me being in the cox seat I was able to stop the boat, and was able to avert a nasty accident. **Emergency Action Taken.** See Above Was anyone injured?
