New Visions' College Access and Action Network develops the capacity of counselors across our core networks to support students' college and career readiness. Over the course of six full-day sessions we provide an opportunity for counselors to work with and learn from colleagues from across the city; deepen understanding of local and regional college access policies and procedures; identify career-related opportunities for their students; and plan how to apply session learnings to their particular school context by focusing on student- and cohort-specific data. CAAN plays a critical role in supporting New Visions' postsecondary vision: by 2022, every New Visions school in our core network will support students and their caregivers to explore college and careers so that students graduate high school with a postsecondary plan that includes best fit education, training or employment and the skills and experience to succeed in that plan.
