

Classroom Display Upgrade: Frequently Asked Questions

What are the benefits of the new displays?	• Lower maintenance: Projectors require lamp replacements and filter changes, which can be disruptive to instruction. This will not be an issue with the LCD panels! • Clearer and brighter display for increased visibility: The LCD panels have higher resolution, are brighter, and the image quality does not deteriorate as quickly as the projectors.
I am no longer able to use my document camera. How else can I model worksheets for students?	<i>Though unsupported by the technology department for five years, some classrooms still had document cameras. While many teachers have adopted other display methods, this change will be new to some. You can airplay from your iPad:</i> • Take a picture of the worksheet and use photo editing & the markup tool to model writing on the worksheet • Position your iPad above the paper, like a document camera, and write on the paper. Here is how you can set up your iPad as a document camera: iPad stand as document camera
I am no longer able to use my document camera. How else can I model hands-on activities for students?	<i>Though unsupported by the technology department for five years, some classrooms still had document cameras. While many teachers have adopted other display methods, this change will be new to some. You can airplay from your iPad and use your iPad camera. There are a few ways to do this:</i> • Create your own iPad stand as document camera • Use an iPad stand bent over the table <i>* The district is looking options to support teachers with this need</i>
Will I still be able to freeze the screen?	Yes, you will need a remote to the display in order to do this. The snowflake button freezes and unfreezes the screen.
I am used to projecting my slides and then writing on them using my whiteboard. How can I achieve the same effect without being able to write on the display?	• Quickest Option. Write directly on Google Slides while presenting. There are no color options and you have to "clear drawing" and cannot erase a portion of your drawing • This option is quick and is good for in the moment decisions to write on the slides: Google Slides to PDF Markup • Create as PDF within another app. This is a good option if you want to organize your slides for the day or week and/or easily return to them with your saved drawings: ◦ Open Google Slidedeck in Explain Basics app ◦ Notes App (starting in Google Drive app) ◦ Notes App (starting in Google Slides app) ◦ FreeForm • Share to Keynote
