1. A phrase is a (Single choice)

- group of words that make sense
- stage of writing development
- group of words that work together but are not a complete clause or sentence**

2. A complete clause (Single choice)

- contains a subject and a predicate**
- is the last sentence in a paragraph
- contains multisyllable words

3. A predicate is a (Single choice)

- guess or prediction about what the sentence means
- a verb
- a verb or verb phrase**

- is taught in grades 3 and up
- has a 'doing' word
- has a subject and a predicate**
