**NOTE: COURSES ARE CONSIDERED CLOSED the entire day until the final putt drops for the round and only competitive play can be out on the course playing. The Family 9 at Dillon and holes 19-27 at Frisco are not considered part of the courses and are available for warm up. First cards of the day are not permitted to be on the course for warm up or practice prior to their rounds. This is also a PDGA A-Tier event, please ensure your attire is appropriate of this level of event. Ripped/Torn, inappropriate or unkept clothing and attire is not allowed.**

**The Courses:**

The Courses both showcase the natural beauty of the Colorado Mountain scene, there is no OB other than naturally occurring water on the courses, as well as beyond the baseball fence on 17/18 at Peak One Frisco. We have some relatively strict rules to follow regarding adding signage and more to the courses and due to this, the courses will really showcase that natural beauty with minimal visual interruptions, we encourage you all to take it in!

We intend to get water out on the courses: Due to not being able to drive on the courses we will pick one spot near the middle of your round for water to be: Your course starter will know where that is and let you know during our brief player meetings. **REMINDER: There are some trash cans and recycle bins at Frisco, but Dillon has minimal to no cans on site: Pack it in and Pack it out! ALSO DO NOT be that person and place empty water bottles back in the cooler, it's rude.**

### **Scoring:**

We will be using the PDGA digital scoring system through [PDGA.com/Scores](https://pdga.com/scores) . The password will be **COSTATES**. EVERYONE from the group is required to keep score, one via the official method, the others via PDGA ideally, but paper, or Udisc is acceptable. The group can decide who keeps the PDGA and who keeps the other PDGA or Udisc. The Digital Scorecard is the OFFICIAL score card of the event. After you complete scoring make sure everyone's score is confirmed prior to anyone leaving for the day.

### **Check In:**

Your check in will be at your specific starting course Friday Morning, no less than 15 minutes before your scheduled tee time. Amateur player pack pick up will exclusively happen at Frisco for all Amateur Divisions, and you can pick it up Friday or Saturday, just look for it under the Trash Panda Tent.

### **Professional Payouts:**

Professional Projected Payouts are posted to the PDGA event page, these are subject to adjustment for the final player count after Saturday's Round. Amateurs this is a reminder this is a trophy only event. All Award Presentations will happen at the conclusion of each division on Sunday. Professional Payouts will be sent via paypal by end of day Monday, July 14th.

Thank you all very much for your support of the 2025 Colorado State Disc Golf Championships and we look forward to crowning our champions for the year!

Next year the Colorado Disc Golf Hall of Fame will be taking a supportive role for the 2026 Colorado State Disc Golf Championships, and our friends at the North Gate Disc Golf Club in
