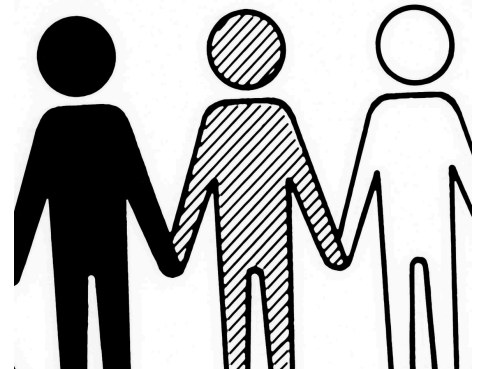


## The Effects Of Racism in Schools
